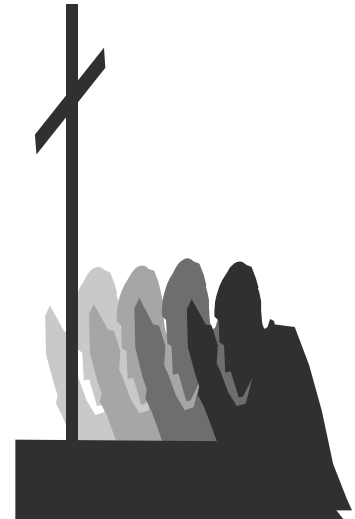

PRAYER CHAIN

When you are a part of the Grace Church E-mail prayer chain the announcement, "You've got mail," may take on a whole new meaning. This may actually be a call to intercessory prayer! You may be asking, "Just what is a Prayer Chain, how does it work and how do I know if I should be a part of this ministry?"

WHAT IS A PRAYER CHAIN?

A Prayer Chain is a group of pastors, elders and Prayer Partners who receive prayer requests by E-mail and then partner in prayer with you concerning your prayer request.

WHAT IS INTERCESSORY PRAYER?

The call to intercessory prayer is a compelling desire to persevere in prayer concerning the needs of others or for our personal needs. Ezekiel 22:30 gives an example of this, "And I searched for a man among them who should build up the wall and stand in the gap before Me for the land..."

HOW DOES THIS WORK?

When you have a prayer request you can communicate your need through the Prayer Chain. You may do this by sending the request by E-mail, by calling our message line or by writing your request on the bulletin, and placing it in the offering. In an emergency our Prayer Chain Leader or Coordinator can be contacted directly.

WHAT IF MY PRAYER REQUEST IS HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL?

We take care to protect your privacy and the confidentiality of your prayer requests by only including necessary information.

HOW DO I PRAY FOR OTHERS?

We pray according to Col. 1:9-12, by praying:

That they know God's will for their lives.

They would do God's will for their lives.

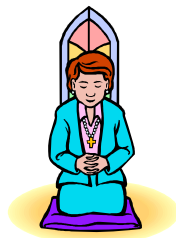
For productivity in their lives.

CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

As a Prayer Chain Prayer Partner of Grace Church, I agree to keep all information that I am given through the Prayer Chain in strict confidence. I understand that breaking of confidentiality will be grounds for my dismissal from the Prayer Chain.

I also commit myself to follow the Biblical pattern commanded in Matthew 18:15-17 in resolving any concerns, grievances, or questions that may arise in my involvement in Grace Church and my relationships with any of its members.

If I have a personal grievance or question that involves any confidential information, I will approach the Prayer Chain Coordinator and will not discuss it with anyone other than my spouse, who will be bound to strict confidence and will be expected to abide by the specifics of this agreement as well.

If, after this, the situation I am concerned about is not resolved I will request a meeting with the Prayer Chain Leader. The concern will be addressed and discussed again, and hopefully resolved to the satisfaction of all. After this meeting and prayer, if my concern is still not resolved, I will request a meeting with a pastor or elder.
